**Louisville, Ky. (March 20, 2013)** - The Eagles have announced the initial concerts for the iconic band's "History of the Eagles" tour, which kicks off on July 6 at the KFC Yum! Center. In celebration of the release of the band's documentary, *History of the Eagles*, which made its television broadcast debut on Showtime last month, the Eagles will perform concerts in Milwaukee, Wisconsin; Cleveland, Ohio; Toronto, Ontario; Ottawa, Ontario; Philadelphia, Pennsylvania; Uncasville, Connecticut; Boston, Massachusetts; Washington, D.C., Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania; and Bethel, New York. Tickets for all currently announced "History of the Eagles" tour dates go on sale beginning Thursday, March 28 at 10 AM.

The Eagles - Glenn Frey, Don Henley, Joe Walsh and Timothy B. Schmit - will perform classics spanning their career including "Hotel California," "New Kid In Town," "Take It To The Limit," "One Of These Nights," "Lyin' Eyes," "Rocky Mountain Way," "Best Of My Love" and "Take It Easy." Hits from band members' solo catalogs will also be featured during the evening.
